

Course Title: Confined Space Awareness

Overview (Target Audience)

The course is designed for Onshore and Offshore personnel with the responsibilities of working in and around confined spaces as part of routine operations. This course will cover horizontal entry and the use of escape breathing apparatus.

During the Training the delegates will cover the following elements:

1. Current legislation
2. 5 steps of risk assessment
3. Hazard identification
4. Managing risk
5. Principles of ventilation
6. Equipment
7. PPE requirements
8. Team roles
9. Emergency arrangements
10. Escape Breathing apparatus sets
11. Horizontal Non-complex entry
12. Moving inside a confined space
13. Self rescue

Elements 10 through to 13 will be performed practically.
