CONVENTIONAL & NON-CONVENTIONAL NDT (QIS)

Non-destructive testing (NDT) performed by our Group company QIS, is a testing that is performed without destroying or impacting the integrity of the item tested. A diverse range of industries use NDT for detecting defects and irregularities and assessing safety in equipment and assets. The growing need to utilise NDT is a result of companies looking to extend the asset life of their plant facilities in addition to adhering to increased regulation. Advanced non-destructive testing methods often require more advanced training and technician skill than traditional NDT inspections, but offer a far greater insight into asset damages.

ROPE ACCESS (QIS)

QIS offers IRATA International's rope access system, which is a safe method of working at height where ropes and associated equipment are used to gain access to and from the work position, and to be supported there.

INSPECTION FOR PLANT & LIFTING (QIS)

QIS offers lifting equipment inspection services under LEEA Approval and ISO/IEC 17020 accreditation. QIS supports their clients by helping them to comply with their responsibilities under local and international regulations and standards. From simple manual lifting machines to cranes with complex control systems, QIS have the in-house expertise and capabilities to inspect professionally and provide independent certifications.

FIRE SAFETY SERVICES (QIS)

QIS provides quality services in the design/engineering, supply, installation, supervision, testing and commissioning, training, and maintenance of all types of fire protection systems including fire alarms and gas detection systems, which consists of firefighting systems, sprinkler systems, dry chemical powder systems, wet chemical systems, fire pumps, water spray systems, water mist systems, pre-action systems, foam systems, kitchen hood systems, FM 200 systems, NOVEC systems, CO2 systems, fire hydrant systems, fire doors, emergency and exit lighting systems, and voice evacuation and public address systems.

Additionally, QIS provides integration with security systems that comply with client requirements, international standards and Qatar Civil Defense regulations.

POST WELD HEAT TREATMENT (QIS)

Welding is an essential part of operating and maintaining assets in many different industries. Whilst it has many useful applications, the welding process can involuntarily deteriorate equipment by exposing enduring stresses into a material, leading to decreased material properties. In order to ensure the material strength of a part is retained after welding, QIS use a process known as post weld heat treatment (PWHT). PWHT can be used to reduce residual stresses, as a method of hardness control, or even to increase material strength.

SPECIALIST MANPOWER SUPPLY (QIS)

QIS supply specialised and skilled manpower including: API Inspectors, welding inspectors, painting inspectors, refractory inspectors, supply of RPO, multi NDT and PWHT technicians



REPAIR, MAINTENANCE AND TESTING OF ANY TYPE OF INDUSTRIAL VALVE (SGQ)

All kinds of valves (ball, gate, globe, butterfly, choke, control) are serviced/repaired in Severn Glocon Qatar workshop. Repairs include welding, machining, lapping and arrangement of spares.

RECONDITIONING OF INDIVIDUAL COMPONENTS INCLUDING WELDING AND NDT SERVICES (SGQ)

If valve components, such as body, adapter, top flange, bonnet, etc. are corroded or pitted, they can be weld repaired and machined to the original specs.

INSTRUMENT WORK AND CALIBRATION OF CONTROL VALVES (SGQ)

New tubing, alterations, and fixing of related accessories for control valves. All kinds of control valves are calibrated and function tested in our dedicated facility.

FUNCTION TESTING OF ACTUATOR VALVES (SGQ)

All types of control valves and SDVs with pneumatic, hydraulic, electrical actuators are function tested at our facility.

RETROFITTING OF CONTROL VALVES (SGQ)

Retrofitting of control valves is one of the main jobs that is performed at SGQ. With the assistance of Severn Glocon PLC, SGQ is able to provide this service to our valuable clients.

DIAGNOSTIC SURVEY FOR CONTROL VALVES (SGQ)

Being the sole agent for Severn Glocon Valves in Qatar, SGQ can assist in studying and analysing process data to be utilised for valve selection, design and troubleshooting.

TROUBLESHOOTING OF VALVES AND ACTUATORS OFFSHORE/ONSHORE (SGQ)

When clients faces any difficulty with any type of valve at site, SGQ can mobilise a specialist to resolve such issues at short notice. SGQ maintains the necessary security passes for different locations to ease the process for quick mobilisation.

VALVE RELATED SHUTDOWN SERVICES (SGQ)
